National Youth Service (NYS) is a youth development institution established in terms of the National Youth Service Act, 2005 (Act no. 6 of 2005). The President is the Head of the Service and assigns its administration to the Ministry of Sports, Youth and National Service. NYS is mandated to offer personal development programs and opportunities for voluntary services to the youth, thereby contributing sustainably to national socio-economic development efforts.

To achieve its mandate, NYS offers a three (3) phase training programme to the youth, namely National Service Training, Voluntary Service and Technical Vocational Education Training (TVET) programmes. NYS is inviting interested and unemployed Namibian youth to apply for enlistment into the first (1) phase of National Service Training. National Service Training is mandatory for all wishing to proceed to Voluntary Service and Skills Training.

National Service Training is a six (6) months training. Upon completion recruits will either be deployed for Voluntary Service into projects of National importance or enrolled for Technical Vocational Education Training (Skills Training) at Rietfontein Training Centre. The NYS TVET programmes are registered with the Namibia Training Authority (NTA) and accredited by the Namibia Qualification Authority (NQA).
